Stadium Information

Fieldhouse

- The Navasota ISD Athletic Director's office is located in the fieldhouse.
- The fieldhouse is 9,000 sq. ft.
- Home locker room is 2,100 sq. ft.
- Visitor locker room is 1,800 sq. ft.
- Each locker room has showers and training areas.

Stadium Seating

- The stadium has a total of 5000 seats in the bleachers.
- The home side bleachers seat 3000.
- The home seats also include 500 seats in the north end of stadium for band and drill teams.
- The visitor side bleachers seat 1500.

Playing Surface

- The field is a field turf artificial playing surface.
- Excellent drainage provides a great surface in all weather conditions.

Scoreboard & Sound System

- The stadium features a 25' X 45' Daktronics scoreboard.
- The scoreboard has a high resolution 9' X 13' video graphics screen.
- The stadium has a state of the art Sports Sound System that is equipped to play cassettes and CDs.
- The stadium has wireless sound capabilities for the head official.

Press Box

- The press box is 1000 sq. ft. – one level – with an elevator.
- Press/Scout areas are separated for both home and visiting teams.
- Home/Visitor radio booths are separated and hold 3 each.
- Team video balcony is separated for Home/Visitors.
- Home Assistant Coaches' box will seat 6.
- Visitor Assistant Coaches' box will seat 6.

Entry Gates

- There are entry gates on both sides of stadium.
- 4 Ticket Booth windows are on west side of stadium for home team.
- 2 Ticket Booth windows are on east side for visiting team.

Concession Stands & Restrooms

- There are two large concession stands located at the north end of stadium for home/visiting team fans.
- Men's/Women's restrooms for home and visitors are located near the concession stands area with no cross over from the two participating schools.

Parking

- Home parking is on the west side of the stadium.
- Visitor parking is on the east side of the stadium.
- There are bus parking spaces available for team and supporting groups at the junior high.

For football games NISD provides:

- Police, security, and parking attendants
- Stadium Manager
- Ticket sellers, ticket takers, and gate keepers (tickets for sale at the gate)
- Announcer and Spotter
- Press Box elevator attendant/Press Box manager
- Game clock operator, 25 second clock operator, and scoreboard operator
- Chain Crew (four man crew)
- Video Display & scoreboard graphics personnel
- Dressing rooms for each team
- Securing all game officials

Special Instructions

- Any regulation football shoe may be worn
- Dressing rooms will open 2 ½ hours before game time.
- Ticket gates will open 1 ½ hours before game time.

Scouting

- Scouts WILL NOT be allowed in the Press Box area.
- All visiting scouts are asked to sit in the General Admission area.

Stadium Regulations

1. Dressing Rooms

- Showers are available for each team.
- Towels are not provided.
- Training room space is available in each dressing room.
- Electrolyte drinks are allowed in the dressing rooms only.
- NISD is not responsible for any articles left in the dressing rooms.
- Visiting teams to Rattler Stadium will be held responsible for negligent damages to dressing rooms.

2. Playing Field

- Teams may have only water on the sidelines – no electrolyte drinks are allowed.
- Absolutely no glass bottles, cans, or food is allowed on the sideline. This includes cheerleaders and support groups.
- All equipment such as training tables, fans, heaters, etc., must have a protective base under them – make arrangements with stadium manager for special requests.
- Absolutely no confetti is allowed.
- Band Props must not scar the field or track. Sharp wheels or edges on equipment are prohibited.
- Spectators are not allowed on the field before, during, or after the game. (This includes spirit lines).
- Inflatable run-throughs **ARE** allowed. No generators will be allowed on the field. We also ask that the inflatable run-through be removed during the game.
- No sunflower seeds, gum, or chewing tobacco are allowed on the field.
- Visiting teams to NISD Stadium will be held responsible for negligent damages to the playing field and track.

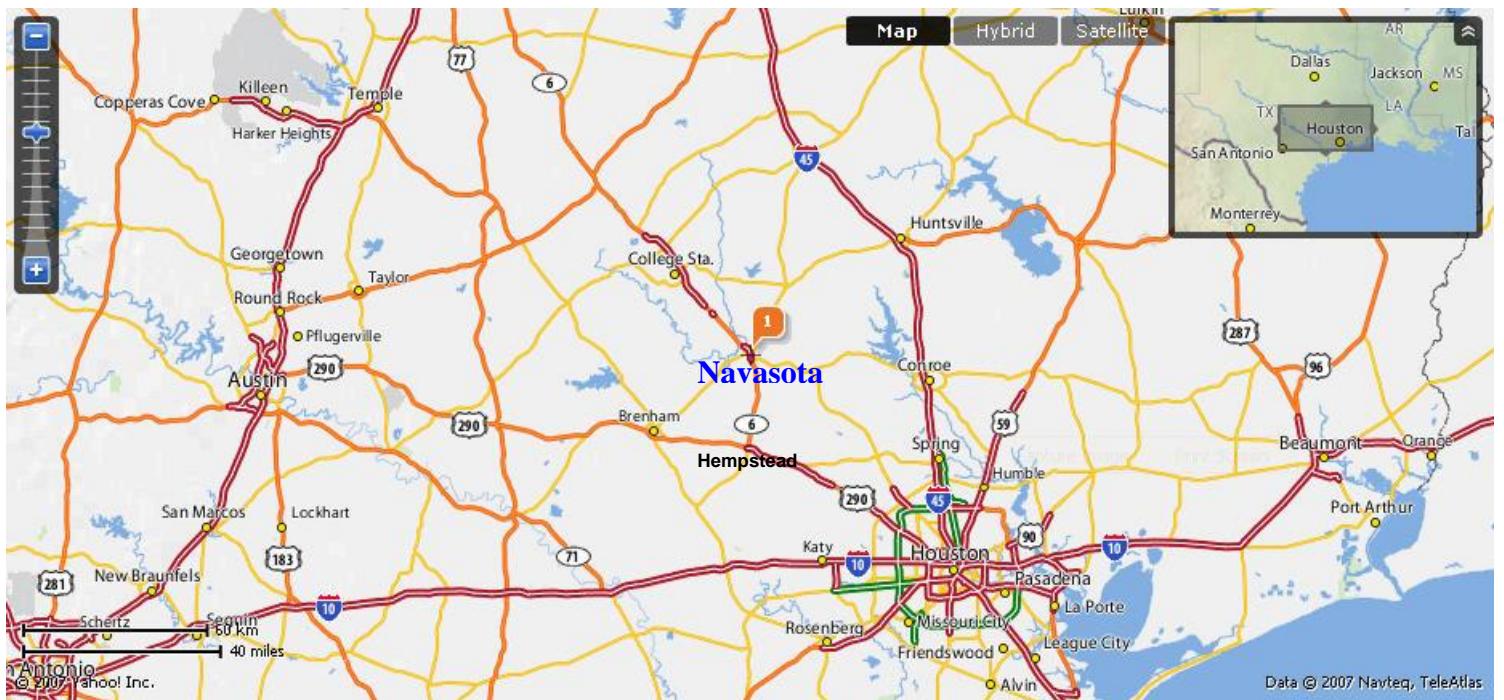
3. Stadium

- Absolutely no climbing or jumping over the rails from bleachers to field will be allowed.
- Permanent paint that will not run when wet must be used on all paper/vinyl signs that will not run when wet. All signs must be made to tie onto stadium structures – No tape can be used to hang signs. (All signs must be removed at the completion of game).
- There are no in and out privileges in the stadium. Once you have entered the stadium you are not allowed to leave without paying to re-enter.

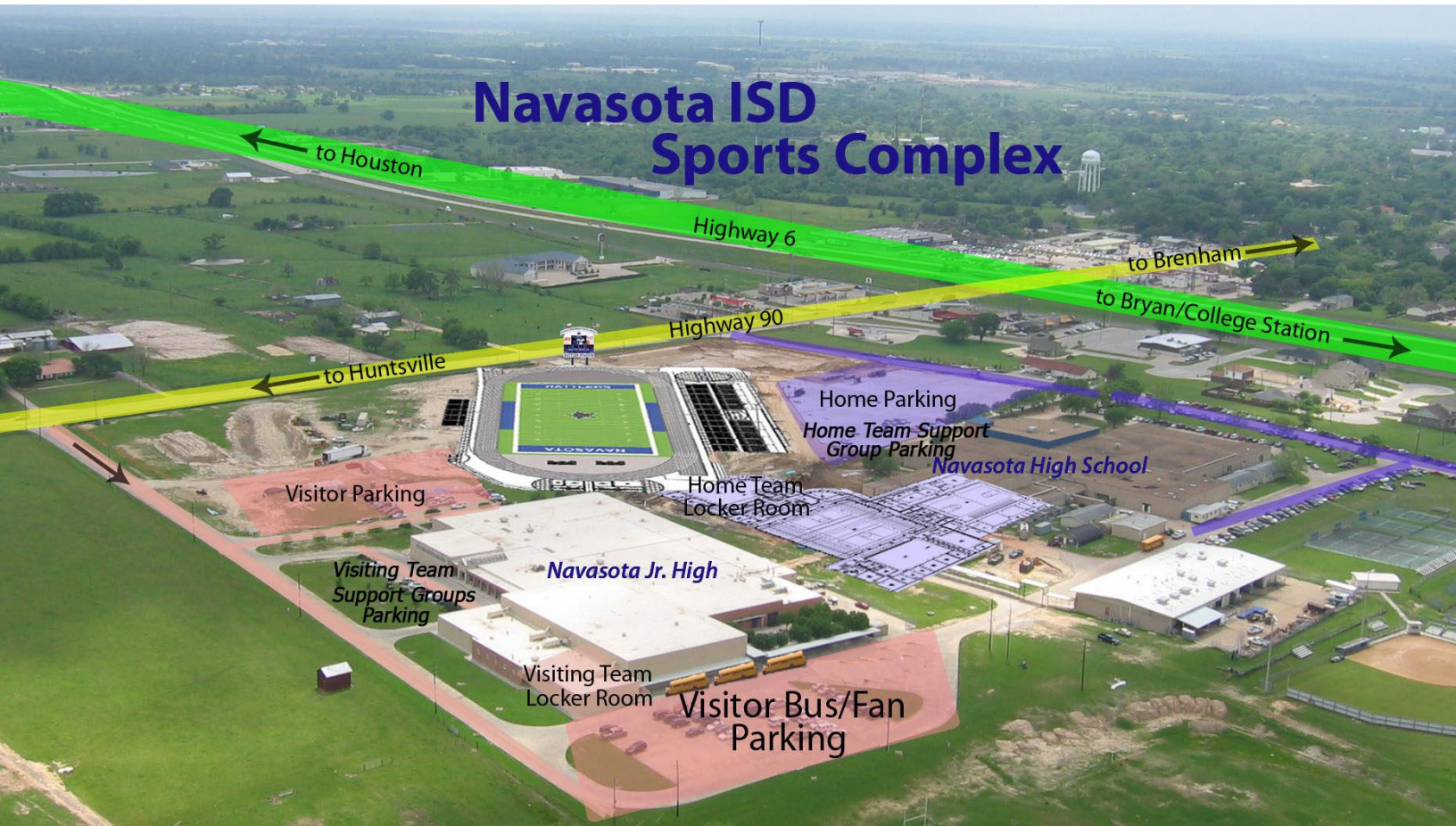
4. Press Box

- Admittance to the Press Box is by PASS ONLY. All scouts must sit in General Admission bleachers.
- School Personnel – a list will be sent to each school with the number of seats that will be available in the Press Box. Names must be filled in and the list returned to the Stadium Manager.
- Media Personnel – must call Stadium Manager to reserve seats prior to the game.
- The Press Box will open 1 ½ hours before game time.

Band Procedures

Parking

Football Games: Visiting bands will park in the circle drive at Navasota Jr. High.

Entry

Visiting bands will enter the stadium through the south side entry gate on visitor's side.

Pit Equipment

All pit equipment will be taken through same entry gate and stored on the outer lane sidewalk inside the playing field. Any equipment that is required on the field must be approved by Stadium Manager prior to game.

Seating

The visiting band will sit in the south end of the visiting bleachers. Please help in conserving seating space for visiting fans.

Press Box

Halftime announcers should go through the band entry gates and use the sidewalk to go to the press box elevator. Your passes for the announcer's booth will be given to Athletic Director of your school. We ask that you start to the Press Box when approximately 5 minutes are left on the game clock.

Halftime Procedures

Field Instructions

1. Make sure that all auxiliary personnel's sideline passes are worn in full view.
2. As the bands enter the field, they and their pit equipment must not pass the 15 yard line until the football team starts to leave the field for halftime.
3. The officials will not start the clock for the halftime performance until the teams have exited the field. This will give you time to setup your pit equipment.
4. Once your performance is over you will exit the field using the same gate of entry.
5. Pit equipment should be placed back on the sidewalk of the outer lane inside the playing field.
