- Brazos Valley Connection is a 345 kV electric transmission line proposed to run from Harris County to Grimes County, crossing through Waller County.
- Cross Texas Transmission is a 345 kV electric transmission line proposed to run from Grimes County to Limestone County, crossing through Madison, Brazos, Robertson, Leon, and Freestone Counties.
- These lines will destroy a minimum of 121 acres of land for every mile they cross, and significantly diminish the value of the adjoining property
- The lines do not provide any benefit for the counties which will be crossed. The lines are being built to benefit Harris County ONLY.
